Decorator's notebook

Wendy Harrop searches for the most stylish ideas for the home

1 This unusual lamp, made from slate chippings and with nickel-plated fittings, is available in various sizes, including a floor-lamp version. This one is 57 x 35cm and costs £1,116.25, excluding shade. The silk shade, which has a fabric 'top' to hide and filter the light, is 21 x 51cm diameter, and costs £330. Both at Alexander von Moltke.

2 'Flora' wallpaper (from left, slate and satin) has a design of flowering stems and branches highlighted in metallic gold and silver. Measuring 52cm wide, it costs £59 a 10-metre roll, from Jocelyn Warner.

3 The 'Canapé Marigny' sofa by Gilles Nouailhac is made of beechwood and is upholstered in grey velvet (cotton mix), with antiqued studs in bronze. Made in France, it is available to order, measures 91 x 200 x 81cm, and costs £3,280, at Frenchy Furniture.

4 Each 'Excess' crystal glass by Saint Louis takes three-and-a-half hours to make. The process includes mouth-blowing, hand-cutting the faceted stem, and polishing the finished glass. Available in flannel grey, red, amethyst or clear, a Champagne flute, wine goblet or water goblet costs from £180 depending on colour, at Harrods.

5 Designer Adam Williams makes elegant bespoke furniture and mirrors. This oval table can be made to any size, and finished in gold or silver leaf, or (as here) patinated bronze, with a 20mm limestone top. It costs from £800, from Adam Williams Design.
