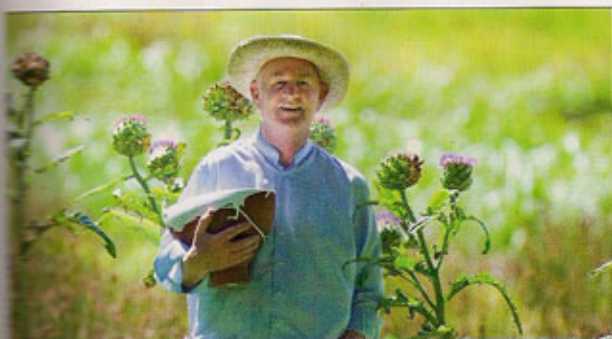
## SLICE IS RIGHT
